Plan Ahead

- 1. Make an appointment at one of the clinics on the Low-Cost Clinics page.
- 2. Start prebaiting and prebait every day.
- 3. Trap the cats one or two days before the appointment. It's ok for the cat to stay in his trap for a day or longer. You can provide food and water for him and keep the trap clean.
- 4. On the day of the appointment, transport the cat to the low-cost clinic.
- 5. Pick up the cat, transport it to a safe enclosed place such as your garage or a shed and hold it there, in its trap, overnight.
- 6. Release the cat in the morning after the sedation has worn off.

Working with Triple R Pets

- 1. Your feral cat will receive the full feral cat spay/neuter package including:
 - Spay/neuter surgery and eartip for visual identification
 - Rabies vaccination (for cats over four months)
 - Distemper vaccination
 - Parasite control for worms, fleas, ticks, earmites
 - Microchip registered with Triple R Pets
- 2. You will be eligible for the discounted rate of \$50 for the above services.
- 3. You and your colony will be registered with Triple R Pets and be legally protected.
- 4. Trap rentals are available to you.
- 5. Triple R Pets provides educational information and trapping tips.
