2024 saw an almost return to normal for the community cats. Clinics were more accessible ... but the cost of TNR went up. Our team of volunteers worked to educate, loan traps and provide support to caretakers with our "Do It Yourself" approach to TNR.

The volunteer leaders within Triple R Pets are the best around! For over eighteen years, we have been able to keep this organization going with only volunteer support. Nobody receives a paycheck from our organization. Instead, every dollar that is donated goes to support our TNR efforts across the South and Southwest areas of Cook County and surrounding areas.

Does TNR make an impact? We emphatically say YES! With a reduction in cat population, shelters see a reduction in intake and thus less unnecessary euthanasia.


Thank you to all our volunteers and caretakers who make Triple R Pets what it is - a community group that comes together to support the cats and the people who care for them.


Cats

545 new cats were registered in 2023, an increase of 45% from 2022 with two focused TNR projects.

Of these 545, 508 received TNR services in 2023, the others were TNR'd in prior years before becoming part of the RRR program.

Financial Overview

Our incredibly generous donor base continued to support TNR efforts in 2023 with our highest income in our eighteen-year history. Unfortunately, this also is a direct reflection on the continued rising costs of TNR packages. Now, more than ever, we need support from the community to continue our programs.





In line with our revenue, our expenses also saw a record setting year. As much of our revenue is simple pass-through for TNR costs, this is expected without any grants or significant donations.



Spend per Cat

Clinic costs continue to rise, placing our clinic spend per cat TNR'd in a reporting year at a historically high rate of \$71.47 per cat.





Financial Detail

For every dollar we receive in donations, 97.2¢ goes directly to our TNR program.

Triple R Pets budgets for a breakeven year. 2023 saw us not quite achieve that. Even though donations grew 11% in 2023, that was not enough to offset the 20% increase in expenses we saw due to the rising costs of spay / neuter surgeries. Note that our administrative costs actually declined in 2023.
