- 4) Microchip

- 1) Spay/Neuter Surgery

- 3) Rabies Vaccination (1 year) w/Cook County tag
- 4) Microchip
- 5) Distemper Vaccination
- 6) Parasite Control (Capstar, if parasites are noted)

Check In Procedures:

Days Open for Feral Surgery Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday

Walk-ins & Appointments Walk-ins allowed up to two cats

Total # of Cats Allowed per Visit Two maximum for walk-in; call for an appointment up to ten

Drop Off Time 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM

Pick Up Time 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM (same day as drop off) NO OVERNIGHTS!

Trap Requirements One cat per trap

Traps must be a minimum of 9X9X30

NO PLASTIC CARRIERS! Must be in a metal trap

Must have a towel covering the trap

Both the trap and the towel must be labeled with the Cat and Caretaker Names
