- 3) Rabies Vaccination (1 year) w/Cook County tag
- 4) Microchip

- 7) Parasite Control (Frontline)
- 8) Convenia (antibiotic, if needed)

### ***Check In Procedures:***

**Days Open for Feral Surgery** Tuesday and Friday

**Walk-ins & appointments** No Walk-Ins Allowed

**Total # of Cats Allowed per Visit** Three maximum with an appointment

**Drop Off Time** 7:15 AM to 8:30 AM

**Pick Up Time** 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM (same day as drop off) NO OVERNIGHTS!

**Trap Requirements** One cat per trap

Traps must be a minimum of 9X9X30

NO PLASTIC CARRIERS! Must be in a metal trap

Must have a towel covering the trap

Both the trap and the towel must be labeled with the Cat and Caretaker Names
