Check In Procedures:

Days Open for Feral Surgery Monday thru Thursday; every other Friday

Walk-ins & Appointments No Walk-Ins Allowed

Total # of Cats Allowed per Visit Two maximum

Drop Off Time 7:00 AM to 8:00 AM or 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM if confirmed by phone

Pick Up Time 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM the next day (cats are held overnight)

Trap Requirements One cat per trap

Traps must be a minimum of 9X9X30

NO PLASTIC CARRIERS! Must be in a metal trap

Must have a towel covering the trap

Both the trap and the towel must be labeled with the Cat and Caretaker Names
